
















## Stranded Silk

A strandable spun silk thread of superior quality. For our Painter's Threads collection we use Soie d'Alger, trade mark of Au Ver a Soie, Paris, France, brand dyed by Tentakulum Manufaktur. You can use it like you would stranded cotton.

One ply is a little bit thicker than stranded cotton. It has a subtle sheen which will vary according to the light. Silk sheen is a natural shimmer, produced by the protein in the fibre not any chemical substance (like mercerising with cotton). So the sheen will not get lost upon washing or ironing.
